Present – Trustee Frost, Trustee Hemphill, Trustee Harkleroad, Fiscal Officer Patton, Police Chief Taillon,


- Mr. Frost opened the meeting and asked Chief Taillon to present the information on the 2010 Chevy Impala Police Interceptor with 4404 miles. The Chief advised that he found the car for sale on the Internet. He talked to the owner and thinks we would be able to purchase the car for \$9500 to \$10,000. He would be able to use the equipment off the cruisers we have now and have spare parts. He advised that it would cost an additional \$2135.00 to put the car on the road. If we would purchase this car we wouldn't have to buy a new one next year.
- Mr. Hemphill is concerned that the car is 7 years old and even with the low mileage, certain things will fail. Radiator, hoses, water hoses, thermostat, etc. But there is a fiscal advantage because we will not have to purchase a car next year unless we would receive a grant for one. He supports checking out the car. The Chief plans on taking the oldest two Chevy's out of service next year and sell.
- Mr. Frost says the advantages of purchasing this car would be that the two Impalas we have now can be parted out. The older cars are used for details now at \$12.00/hour.

**RESOLUTION#17-040:** Mr. Frost moved and Mr. Harkleroad seconded the motion to purchase the 2010 Chevrolet Impala Police Interceptor for up to \$10,000 if the car checks out by the Chief and Mark Plant. The trustees are only purchasing the car because of the fact that we will not have to buy a car for the year of 2018. Vote was unanimous.


